What is it?

The Data Fitness Score shows whether data are fit to submit. It is based on the data's conformance to CDISC standards and regulatory guidance. It factors in issue frequency and impact, the logical relationships among records, and consistency between the define/spec and the data.

How to Improve Your Data Fitness Score

Fix 1 Reject Issue	+26 points
Fix all 24 High Issues	+26 points
Fix all 50 Medium Issues	+23 points
Fix all 19 Low Issues	+5 points
